STREET CRIMES UNIT

The Street Crimes Unit focuses on criminal apprehension, nonconventional investigations, and proactive, intelligence-based policing. Partnering with CID, Patrol, and our neighboring and regional partners, SCU addresses high risk, repeat offenders and works to disrupt the criminal element in the region.



BOMB SQUAD

We have a fully trained and equipped Bomb Squad that responds to explosives calls across the entire southeast Washington region.

DETECTIVES

Our Criminal Investigation Division handles all types of complex investigations from child abuse to homicides. We have our own highly equipped computer forensic lab where work is done within the agency. Additionally, RPD has detectives represented in the Tri-Cities Metro Drug Task force.

The SER-ICAC task force is a collaborative law enforcement effort dedicated to combating the proliferation of internet crimes against children in the Southeast region.

USE OF FORCE INSTRUCTORS


