The following are accepted; please call for pick up or for more information:

- Functional vinyl windows, with intact flanges
- Roofing shingles, intact bundles only
- Electrical fixtures in original manufacturers’ carton, must be UL listed Recessed light must be rated for direct contact with thermal insulation
- Sheetrock; intact, undamaged
- Fiberglass insulation bats, 22” wide, without vapor barrier
- Complete panels of 1/2” OSB and T-111 siding
- Glazed tile flooring, unused 100 sq. ft. area
- Shower/tub enclosures are accepted by review

The following items are **not accepted**:

- Paint, pesticides
- Previously opened containers of drywall mud, concrete, mortar, plaster, grout or other chemicals
- Used electrical devices
- Partial sheets of sheetrock
- Used carpet
- Used plumbing fixtures
- Used kitchen appliances

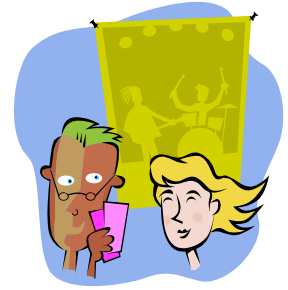
