ORDINANCE NO. 10-20

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2020 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund for Coronavirus Response.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2019, the Richland City Council approved Ordinance No. 55-19 approving the 2020 Budget; and

WHEREAS, in response to the impacts of the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has granted an additional \$179,543 to the City of Richland's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program for the purpose of Coronavirus response; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified community needs, and amended its 2020 Annual Action Plan through Resolution No. 65-20 to allocate the additional funding for Coronavirus relief and response; and

WHEREAS, when the 2020 Budget was approved, no funds were appropriated in the Community Development Block Grant Fund for Coronavirus response.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Amendment of the 2020 Budget. The 2020 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the Community Development Block Grant Fund from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development as follows:

Current Appropriation: \$ 474,246 Increase in Appropriation: \$ 179,543 Amended Appropriation: \$ 653,789
