

ORDINANCE NO. 27-20

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2020 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the City's General Fund.

WHEREAS, on November 19, 2019, the Richland City Council approved Ordinance No. 55-19 approving the 2020 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Police Department (SPD) is the Lead Agency for Washington State's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force; and

WHEREAS, SPD receives funding to support investigations and prosecution of ICAC crimes, and shares this funding with participating Task Force members such as the Richland Police Department (RPD) to further the mission of the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, SPD, as lead agency for the Washington State ICAC Task Force, will provide to RPD state pass-through funds in an amount not to exceed \$275,250 to be used for a forensic van for the ICAC detectives; and

WHEREAS, no funds were appropriated in the 2020 Budget in the General Fund for the purchase of a forensic van.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

Section 1. Amendment of the 2020 Budget. Funding as described herein is hereby accepted from the Seattle Police Department, and the 2020 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the General Fund for the purchase of a forensic van as follows:

<u>General Fund</u>	
Current Appropriation:	\$ 63,004,264
Increase in Appropriation:	\$ <u>275,250</u>
Amended Appropriation:	<u>\$ 63,279,514</u>

Section 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Seattle Police Department setting out the terms and conditions of the pass-through funding as determined to be in the best interests of the City.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
