ORDINANCE NO. 22-21

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending the 2021 Budget to provide for additional appropriations in the City's General Fund.

WHEREAS, on November 17, 2020, the Richland City Council approved Ordinance No. 46-20 approving the 2021 Budget; and

WHEREAS, Washington State SB 5092 (2021-2022) provides funds to assist cities with one-time costs associated with law enforcement and criminal justice-related legislation enacted between January 1, 2020 and June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richland received \$235,259 in city assistance funds; and

WHEREAS, the Richland Police Department desires to purchase body-worn cameras, dashboard cameras, air cards, interview room cameras, and tasers with these funds; and

WHEREAS, no funds were appropriated in the General Fund for the purchase of body-worn cameras or other items mentioned herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Amendment of the 2021 Budget. The 2021 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the General Fund from the one-time allocation of \$235,259 from Washington State SB 5092 (2021-2022) as follows:

General Fund

Current Appropriation: \$ 68,177,111 Increase in Appropriation: \$ 235,259 Amended Appropriation: \$ 68,412,370

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
