## ORDINANCE NO. 24-21

AN ORDINANCE of the City of Richland amending Richland Municipal Code Section 2.48.010 related to membership on the police relief and pension fund board of trustees.

WHEREAS, the City has need, from time to time, to amend the Richland Municipal Code to eliminate ambiguities or come into compliance with established practice or policy; and

WHEREAS, recent staff changes have created an opportunity to review the composition of the LEOFF I police and fire pension board membership; and

WHEREAS, to ensure continuity and consistency between the City's two LEOFF I pension boards, the City's best interests are served by appointing the same two city staff positions to serve as voting members on each board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Richland Municipal Code Section 2.48.010, entitled Board of trustees created, as first enacted by Ordinance No. 31, and last amended by Ordinance No. 38-83, is hereby amended to read as follows:

## 2.48.010 Board of trustees created.

There is created and established the board of trustees of the police relief and pension fund, which shall have the membership and exercise the powers, duties and responsibilities prescribed in Chapter 41.20 RCW. For the purposes of membership prescribed in RCW 41.20.010(1), the support services finance director shall be deemed to be the treasurer.

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.

<u>Section 3</u>. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

<u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance, including but not limited to the correction of scrivener's errors/clerical errors, section numbering, references, or similar mistakes of form.
