ORDINANCE NO. 2022-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 2022 BUDGET TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CITY'S GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, on November 16, 2021, the Richland City Council approved Ordinance No. 39-21 approving the 2022 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Seattle Police Department (SPD) is the Lead Agency for Washington State's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force; and

WHEREAS, SPD receives funding to support investigations and prosecution of ICAC crimes, and shares this funding with participating Task Force members such as the Richland Police Department (RPD) to further the mission of the Task Force; and

WHEREAS, SPD, as lead agency for the Washington State ICAC Task Force, will provide to RPD state pass-through funds in an amount not to exceed \$55,000 to be used to support RPD's ICAC overtime, travel/training, equipment and software necessary for ICAC investigation; and

WHEREAS, no funds were appropriated in the 2022 Budget in the General Fund for the state pass-through funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Amendment of the 2022 Budget. The 2022 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the General Fund from the Seattle Police Department as follows:

Current Appropriation: \$83,869,820 Increase in Appropriation: \$55,000 Amended Appropriation: \$83,924,820

<u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
