ORDINANCE NO. 2023-10

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING CHAPTER 11.08 OF THE RICHLAND MUNICIPAL CODE RELATED TO SPEED REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City has need, from time to time, to amend the Richland Municipal Code (RMC) to update standards and improve clarity; and

WHEREAS, state law regulates speeds on City streets except as provided in Chapter 11.08 RMC – Speed Regulations; and

WHEREAS, upon engineering review, several streets require speed limit adjustments; and

WHEREAS, speed reductions for school zones have been identified and placed in the appropriate code section; and

WHEREAS, as authorized in RCW 46.61.440, a speed reduction for a playground zone on Broadmoor Street is recommended; and

WHEREAS, the City's best interests are served by adopting these speed limits to maintain vehicle mobility and safe operation of the street system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 11.08 of the Richland Municipal Code, entitled Right-of-Way Construction, as first enacted by Ordinance No. 413, and last amended by Ordinance No. 24-16, is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 11.08 SPEED REGULATIONS

Sections:

- 11.08.010 State speed laws applicable.
- 11.08.020 Increasing speed limit in certain zones.
- 11.08.030 Decrease of state law maximum speed.
- 11.08.040 Regulation of speed by traffic signals.
- 11.08.050 Decrease of posted speed in construction zones.

11.08.010 State speed laws applicable.

The state traffic laws regulating the speed of vehicles shall be applicable upon all streets within this city, except as this code, as authorized by state law, declares and determines upon the basis of engineering and traffic investigation that certain speed regulations shall be applicable upon specified streets or in certain areas, in which event it is unlawful for any person to drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of any speed so declared in this code when signs are in place giving notice thereof.

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11.08.020 Increasing speed limit in certain zones.

It is determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law upon the following streets and segments thereof is less than is reasonable and safe under the conditions found by such investigation to exist upon such streets; and except when signs are posted pursuant to state law setting a different maximum speed, the maximum speed permitted on such streets shall be as set forth in this section at the times specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof, but in no case shall the speed limit exceed 60 miles per hour:

11.08.030 Decrease of state law maximum speed.

Wright Avenue from Duportail Street to Van Giesen Street

It is determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by state law upon the following streets is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist upon such streets. The speed limit shall be as set forth in this section on those streets or parts of streets designated in this section at the times specified when signs are erected giving notice thereof.

11.08.040 Regulation of speed by traffic signals.

The traffic engineer is authorized to regulate the timing of traffic signals so as to permit the movement of traffic in an orderly and safe manner.

11.08.050 Decrease of posted speed in construction zones.

A. Authority. The public works director shall have the authority to order placement of a reduced speed limit to regulate speeds in construction zones on city roadways as part of an approved traffic control plan. A roadway construction zone is an area where construction, repair, or maintenance work is being conducted by public employees or private contractors, on or adjacent to any public roadway. In no case shall the reduced speed limit be less than that authorized under RCW 46.61.415.

- B. Regulation. No person may drive a vehicle in a roadway construction zone at a speed greater than the posted speed limit when signs are erected giving notice thereof.
- C. Penalty. A person found to have committed any infraction relating to speed restrictions in a roadway construction zone shall be assessed a monetary penalty equal to twice the penalty assessed under RCW 46.63.110. This penalty may not be waived, reduced or suspended. A person who drives a vehicle in a roadway construction zone in such a manner as to endanger or be likely to endanger any persons or property, who removes, evades or intentionally strikes a traffic safety or control device is guilty of reckless endangerment of roadway workers. A violation of this section is a gross misdemeanor punishable under Chapter 9A.20 RCW and includes both monetary penalties and the suspension of license or permit to drive or a nonresident driving privilege, for up to 60 days, of a person convicted of reckless endangerment of roadway workers.
- <u>Section 2</u>. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.
- <u>Section 3</u>. Should any section or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, that decision shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.

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<u>Section 4</u>. The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary corrections to this Ordinance, including but not limited to the correction of scrivener's errors/clerical errors, section numbering, references, or similar mistakes of form.
