

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-17

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHLAND, WASHINGTON,
AMENDING THE 2023 BUDGET TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL
APPROPRIATIONS IN THE CITY'S GENERAL FUND.**

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2022, Richland City Council passed Ordinance No. 2022-39, approving the 2023 Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature has recognized the resiliency and mental health of law enforcement officers as being a necessary component to the effective delivery of law enforcement services to the community; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2023, Richland City Council approved Resolution No. 2023-29, authorizing a consultant agreement with Obsidian Forensics for the provision of behavioral health services for the Richland Police Department Officer Resiliency Program; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2023, Richland City Council approved Resolution No. 2023-109, authorizing a grant agreement with the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission in the amount of \$69,600 for the continued implementation of the Richland Police Department Officer Resiliency Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds provided by the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission have been accepted by the City of Richland and must now be appropriated in the 2023 Budget for use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City of Richland as follows:


Section 1. Amendment of the 2023 Budget. The 2023 Budget is hereby amended to provide additional appropriations in the General Fund from the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission grant as follows:

Current Appropriation:	\$79,901,856
Increase in Appropriation:	<u>\$ 69,600</u>
Amended Appropriation:	<u>\$79,971,456</u>


Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect the day following its publication in the official newspaper of the City of Richland.

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
