Tri-Cities Area Law Enforcement and Fire Competes for Charity at the 2024 Police vs. Fire Hockey Game

Richland, Wash., – On Saturday, February 3, 2024., local law enforcement and fire agencies will compete in the annual Tri-City Police vs. Fire Hockey Game, in partnership with the Tri-City Americans. This yearly event brings friendly and rivalrous competition to the Toyota Center for an early evening of fun and fundraising. 15% of ticket sales for the evenings event will benefit the Washington State Fraternal Order of Police memorial fund as well as local cancer patients through the Tri-Cities Cancer Center.

With American hockey holding a deep-seeded history in the U.S., it was only natural that this family tradition be brought to the Tri-Cities as an annual weekend entertainment option. This event was first launched in 2016 and continued through the 2017 season. Taking a break for roughly 5 years, the event made its return in 2022, occurring on a dedicated First Responder Night celebration. The game is always played prior to a normal season Americans game against the Spokane Chiefs. Tickets purchased for the Police vs. Fire Hockey Game will also gain admission into the evening's Americans game at 6:05PM.

Tri-City Americans season ticket holders will have access to the Police vs. Fire Game, prior to the regular season game.
