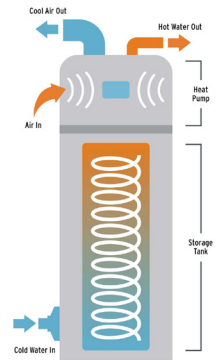

HYBRID WATER HEATER PROGRAM

Did you know that water heaters account for an average of 19% of a home's energy consumption? Hybrid Water Heaters (HPWH) work much more efficiently than their standard electric counterparts, and that means you can save up to 60% on your monthly electric water heating costs for years to come.



The City of Richland is offering a DIY Hybrid Water Heater Rebate Program, available to all qualified Richland residents. This program offers an \$800 instant rebate when purchasing a HPWH through GenPac, Inc.

Installation can be performed by the homeowner or an Authorized Contractor, who will install the HPWH and answer HPWH questions.

The City of Richland offers special low-interest financing on HPWH loans up to \$5,000.
