Appointment	The current procedure for filling vacancies requires an incumbent to reapply

Term of Office	Members shall serve staggered three-year terms.
Compensation	This is a non-salaried appointment.
Duties	The Economic Development Committee serves as an advisory body to the
	City Council to formulate economic goals, strategies, and policies for the City
	in a structured framework providing both time and measurement criteria;
	assess existing economic development policies for the purpose of
	recommending such modifications, as may be appropriate, to assure
	achievement of economic goals approved by City Council.
Meetings	Meetings are held on the third Monday of each month at 4:00 p.m.
	Attendance at additional meetings is sometimes required.
