Agreement No. IG-2387 by and between the STATE OF WASHINGTON, OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE, WASHINGTON STATE LIBRARY DIVISION, hereinafter referred to as the "Agency", and RICHLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor", is amended as follows:

**PERIOD OF PERFORMANCE** is hereby revised as follows:

Subject to its other provisions, the period of performance of this Agreement shall commence on the date of execution of this contract, and be completed on June 30, 2009, unless terminated sooner as provided herein.

**COMPENSATION** is hereby amended as follows:

Internet Connectivity fee Annual Charge is hereby estimated at \$1,200 annually per the revised fee table, Exhibit A, Annual Co-pay: Public Libraries Connecting to K-20 Network.

Internet Connectivity is provided through the University of Washington.

**CONTRACT MANAGEMENT** is hereby revised as follows:

\*\*Circuit co-pays beyond one full T1 are based on actual ISP usage measured at the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile and are independent of transport mechanism. Circuit charges beyond four T1 equivalents (6 Mbps: \$10,000) measured at 95<sup>th</sup> percentile usage increase at \$250/Mbps per year.
